

Expectations and guidance for ALL students and adult leaders.

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Biblical References used as guides: 1 Corinthians 8; 1 Peter 2:15-17; Romans 12:1-2

We believe we should be living proof of Jesus' love and therefore honor God and others in every aspect of our lives, which includes but not limited to: our thoughts, how we act, what we say and how we say it, and the way we choose to dress.

Attire:

- ✓ No vulgar, violent, or sexually suggestive content on clothing.
- \checkmark Shorts must be fingertip length or longer when arms are placed down beside the legs.
- \checkmark No micro dresses or skirts. Length may not be shorter than the top of your knees.
- ✓ If wearing leggings, you must have both your front & rear covered <u>at all times</u> by a long shirt or tied jacket.
 - Those areas <u>must stay covered even when</u> arms are raised above your head. We play active games that utilize various body movements.
- ✓ No mid-drift, cleavage, or bra straps showing.
- ✓ No sheer or see-through clothing.
- ✓ During events or trips that include water, all swimsuits must follow all the above clothing guidance. Also:
 - No speedos.
 - One-pieces are required and must always be worn with shorts over the suit.
 - Tankinis or bikinis require a t-shirt/swim shirt/rash guard worn over them at all times plus shorts as mentioned above.
 - T-shirts, swim shirts, or rash guards may be a good idea no matter what for events including slip n slides. They are required during summer camp (per Crossings camp rules) especially when walking to and from the pool/lake/water activities.

Behavior/ Speech:

- ✓ Everyone should be treated with the kind of respect, love, and support to which scripture calls us and Christ is our example of. Actions and speech should be uplifting, encouraging, seasoned with salt, respectful, and exemplify Christ's love.
- ✓ Respect towards adult leaders: listening and following their instructions.
- ✓ No communication of explicit, sexual, or threatening language or images.

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Honor Code

- ✓ No physical or verbal bullying. This includes any communication shared through social media or electronically student to student, student to adult leader, and adult leader to student.
- ✓ The following are considered inappropriate for student to student, student to adult leader, adult leader to student:
 - Sitting on laps
 - Kissing
 - "Dog-Piling" or laying on top of one another
 - Inappropriate Touching (Examples of Positive Touches: Touching hands, shoulders, or arms, wrapping arm around shoulders; Brief hugs or side hugs; Pats on the shoulder or back; Leaning head on shoulder; Handshakes, high-fives, hand slapping, fist bumps, holding hands.)
 - "Pants-ing," snapping bra straps, giving "wedgies" or similar touch of underwear whether or not it is covered by other clothing.
- ✓ Blankets (and beds on overnight trips) may only be occupied by one person.
- ✓ During travel to and from events, whether during the day or at night, males must sit with males and females must sit with females.

* ZERO TOLERANCE for severe or illegal behavior such as assault, weapons in possession, theft, destruction of property, sexual activity, smoking, drinking, possession of illegal drugs, or any other behavior that could put students or others in danger.


At the discretion of the Student Pastor, code breakers may be:

- 1.) Given two warnings by any adult leader and given suggestions for appropriate behavior.
- 2.) Continued violation may result in removal of student from the activity for a period of time to a visible location AND/OR be sent home at the expense and inconvenience of a parent/guardian.
- 1.) In instances of repeated, severe, or illegal behavior, a student will be immediately removed from the activity, contact made with parent or guardian, and suspended from LPSM activities for a designated period of time. If it is an illegal activity, the police will be contacted followed by a parent/guardian. The student will be welcomed back when it is determined that he/ she is ready to respect others and the LPSM Honor Code.

South Campbellsville Baptist Church does have 24/7 security cameras in a multitude of locations throughout the building. For safety on Wednesdays, the doors remain locked from the outside. A greeter/security team member will let students in downstairs for IMPACT! on Wednesdays beginning at 5:55pm. Living Proof Student Ministries keeps a student to adult leader ratio of approximately 6:1.
